Their latest, "Homecoming", was picked by **Jazziz** magazine for their "**Best of 2009**" CD, along with tracks by Chick Corea, John McLaughlin, Branford Marsalis, and other heavyweights.

Paul's three solo acoustic CDs, "Steel-String Americana", "Roots and Branches", and "From Adamant To Atchafalaya", received numerous rave reviews for their fresh takes on blues and jazz standards, old-timey country tunes, and original pieces from the "american roots" tradition.
