His jazz-fusion group **Kilimanjaro** has released several award-winning recordings, and performed at jazz festivals worldwide, including **Montreux**, **Montreal**, **Atlanta**, and **Roskilde**, in Copenhagen. Their "**Homecoming**" CD was picked by **Jazziz** magazine for their "**Best of 2009**" CD, along with tracks by **Chick Corea**, **John McLaughlin**, **Branford Marsalis**, and other heavyweights.

Paul's three solo acoustic CDs, "Steel-String Americana", "Roots and Branches", and "From Adamant To Atchafalaya", received numerous rave reviews for their fresh takes on blues and jazz standards, old-timey country tunes, and original pieces from the "american roots" tradition.
